Category "A" competitors were challenged to find all 5 transmitters and Category "B" competitors 4 transmitters (any 4) Only 2 category "A" competitors found all 5 transmitters within the time limit and for some reason Ewen a category "B" competitor also found all 5 transmitters. Ewen either missed the note about having to only find 4 or he decided he had enough time to get one more. Well done Ewen!
